The Eucharistic procession is also known as a Corpus Christi procession because of its association with the Feast of Corpus Christi. The full name of this feast is Corpus et Sanguis Christi, or the Body and Blood of Christ. The Feast of the Body and Blood of the Lord and the procession with the Blessed Sacrament, celebrating the sacrament and signifying God's presence in our world and in our lives and reminding us of our common pilgrimage to Heaven, is a prayerful and edifying act of the entire Church.

After the Solemn mass, our pastor **Fr. Xavier De Pinto** and invited guest priests will lead the procession of the Blessed Sacrament joined by our parishioners, friends and neighbours.

Our Eucharistic procession route will be from the Church to Lawrence Avenue to Pharmacy Avenue then Janet Blvd to Victoria Park and back to the Church on Lawrence Avenue.
