

Feast of Santo Niño or Holy Child Jesus

Here at Precious Blood, we invite you to bring your Santo Niño statues for special blessings in all masses on Sat/Sun January 25-26, 2020.

Holy Child-Santo Niño is a Roman Catholic title of a statue of the Child Jesus of Philippines. The image is venerated as miraculous by many Filipino Catholics. It is one of the oldest Christian relics in the Philippines, originally given in 1521 as a gift by explorer Ferdinand Magellan to Raiah



Humabon and his wife when he landed on the island.

The image has historically attracted devotional worship in Philippines, attracting devotional worship, processions and pilgrimage, with numerous Filipino pilgrims touching or kissing the foot of the idol's stand. There is an annual feast every third Sunday of January. **Viva Sto. Niño!**
