

On the weekends starting on November 4 and 5 and including Sunday, November 12 the Knights of Columbus will be handing out the casserole containers at the


front entrance of the church so parishioners can take them home and make a Casserole per the recipe inside the containers that have been given to us by the Good Shepard Ministry.
