Adorers of the Blessed Sacrament, lead the rosary, recitation of chaplet of the Divine Mercy and Cantors.



DID YOU KNOW?...

Grace, that comes from the Latin word, "gratia", has a rich meaning: gift, favour, loving kindness, and the thanksgiving that accompanies a gift.

God's grace is a gift to us, a gift that we can't earn and we don't deserve. It is freely given.

Catholics distinguish among different types of grace:

Sanctifying, or habitual grace: The grace that heals us from sin at baptism, making us a new and holy creation.

Actual grace: The grace through which we experience God's help to us throughout our lives.

Sacramental graces constitute the gifts conferred with the sacraments. A distinct grace is imparted by each of the seven sacraments, corresponding to their respective purpose.

Special graces or charisms are manifested in unique and miraculous ways.

Graces of state accompany the exercise of the responsibilities of the Christian life and the various ministries within the Church.

The traditional practice of grace before meals illustrates one particular aspect of the grace, that is, the thanksgiving for a gift.
