

DID YOU KNOW?...

The term "The Four Marks of the Church" describes four major distinctive characteristics of the Christian Church: One - holy - catholic and apostolic.

This belief was first expressed in 381 AD by the First Council of Constantinople. It was then made part of the (then 56 year old) Nicene Creed and kept as such ever since: "[We believe in] one holy catholic and apostolic Church".

The Church is **one** because its source is the Holy Trinity, because it was founded by Jesus, who redeemed all humankind by His blood, and because of the Holy Spirit, the "soul" of the church, who dwells in the souls of, and unites, all the faithful in one community of believers.

The Church is **holy**. The source of holiness is the Lord, who is always present to us in "His body which is the Church". Also, as members of the church, through our baptism, we have been called to holiness. Although, we, as individuals, fail to remain holy at times, since we sin, the church, as a whole, is always an instrument of holiness. That is why we pray before the Sign of Peace: "Lord, look not on our sins, but on the faith of your Church".

The Church is **catholic**, which means "universal", because the Lord has founded it for everyone: "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations..." (Matthew 28:19). Also, the Church here on Earth is united to the triumphant Church in Heaven and both are united with the Church in the Purgatory, thus fulfilling its universality.

The Church is **apostolic**. Christ founded the Church and entrusted His authority to the Apostles, who, in fact, were the first bishops. This authority was handed down through the Sacrament of Holy Orders, in what we call apostolic succession. Also, the faith found in the Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition was preserved, taught and handed down by the apostles.
