Thus, the composed word means "about the whole" or "universal". The word "Catholic" was first used by Ignatius of Antioch around the year A.D. 110.

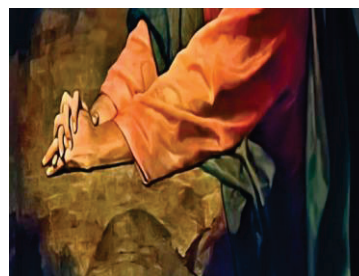
As Our Lord asked of His disciples: **“Could you not watch one hour with me?” (Mk 14:37)**
