DID YOU KNOW?...



In today's Gospel passage Jesus transforms water to wine. This is His first miracle performed in the Gospel of John. Together with the visitation of the Magi and His baptism, this first miracle reveals His identity: the Messiah.

By His presence at the wedding in Cana, Jesus confirms the importance of marriage and that of love, as basis for marriage. The Church teaches that marriage is a sign of the Lord's presence.

Marriage is one of the seven sacraments. It is more than a legal contract. It is a covenant, based on the mutual love of the spouses, and into which they enter freely. It is valid until death because it is an act of total self-giving.

Unlike all other sacraments, marriage is administered by the participating spouses themselves, conferring it on one another. It is blessed by God and witnessed by the presiding priest or deacon.

The Old Testament speaks highly about marriage, the covenant based on the love between husband and wife, and Jesus raises this marital covenant to the dignity of sacrament.

Even in difficult times let's remember and trust that He, who had the power to change water into wine, also has the power to turn ordinary love between spouses into a graced reality.
