DID YOU KNOW?...

"Pentecost" is the Greek for "fifty days" and it is the Greek name of the Jewish Feast of Weeks ("Shavuot" in Hebrew), which in turn, celebrates the giving of the Law to Moses on Mount Sinai.

On this Sunday, which concludes the 50-day Easter season, we celebrate Pentecost, the conferral of the Holy Spirit upon the gathered Apostles.

We consider Pentecost to be the Birthday of the Church, because, as described in today's first reading, it was on this day that the Apostles went out for the first time, and preached the message of the Lord. As a result, many people converted and were baptized.

This grace of receiving the Holy Spirit continues to be celebrated through the sacrament of Confirmation, received at this point in history at age 13 (grade 7). Adults who are being received into the church also participate in this sacrament, usually at Easter Vigil.

Through this Sacrament we are sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit. Actually, the Holy Spirit is received at Baptism and Confirmation completes this Baptismal grace. The gift of the Holy Spirit, received at Confirmation strengthens us so that we may be witness to Christ, just like the Apostles.

In the early church Confirmation was carried out by the laying on of hands. Soon, the anointing with the oil of chrism on the forehead was added. A "Christian" is one who is "anointed".
