The 2025 Report to Parishioners is now posted on our website (home page / News and Announcements). Printed copies are available for your convenience at the office.

The weekly Offertory collection changed little from 2024 to 2025.

Thankfully, other donations (particularly a few noteworthy individuals) plus generous donations from CWL, K of C, Social Committee events and the Simbang Gabi novena helped cover our operating expenses.

With the assistance of everyone who contributed in 2025, the under-staffing of the parish has been significantly alleviated this year by returning to full-time office assistance during the week. Already many of our parishioners have noted our improved ability to respond to your needs. Your generosity in 2025 also allowed us to invest the building fund donations so that unforeseen repairs and long-anticipated improvements can begin, such as the very welcome new appliances in the kitchen.

We are in a hopeful financial state. We could ensure greater financial stability for the parish if the weekly Offertory could increase, which should cover most of our operating expense without relying on extraordinary donations. 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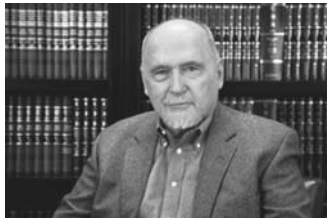
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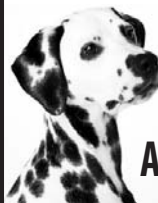
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
